



Two Postdoctoral Fellow Positions Available in Prof. Yan Yu's Laboratory

The Yu laboratory is currently at Indiana University Bloomington and will move to Washington University at St. Louis (WashU) starting July 2025. The postdoctoral fellows selected are expected to move to WashU in 2025.

Two postdoc openings are presently available in Prof. Yan Yu's laboratory.

Job summary: The main research project is to employ optical imaging and nanotechnology-based tools to investigate immune cell functions, including membrane organization and endocytosis.

Qualifications: The candidate must have received Ph.D. in related discipline at the start of the appointment.

The candidate should have expertise in one or more areas as follows:

- High-resolution fluorescence imaging (for candidates with strong expertise in optics, no experience on cell studies is necessary).
- Cell biology and biophysics, with priority given to expertise related to cell membranes, membrane receptors, intracellular membrane organelles.
- Immunology and immune engineering.
- Mechanobiology.
- Bioanalytical chemistry, with priority given to expertise related to developing cell sensing techniques.
- Candidates with interdisciplinary backgrounds are also welcome to join, bringing new ideas and technologies to the lab.

A competitive salary along with a benefits package will be offered. The initial appointment for each position will be for 12 months. Renewal of appointment will be available based on performance and/or availability of funds.
